The Minack Theatre

Most of you will be familiar with, perhaps even visited, this amazing theatre that clings to Minack Cliffs and this year it is to be our Memorial Monday visit.

The guided tour will be led by an actor in the guise of Billy Rawlings who was one of Rowena Cade's gardeners and the person who helped her move granite boulders over the winter of 1931 into 1932 to create the lower terraces which remain pretty much as they were at that time.
